

TRADITION NINE HOLE LADIES GOLF LEAGUE 2026

BE COURTEOUS & RESPECTFUL

While another player is addressing the ball remain still and do not talk.
Stay out of player's peripheral vision on the tee and green.

PRIOR TO THE GAME

If you must cancel, do so before Sunday before 4:00 pm. After 4:00pm call the clubhouse.
In inclement weather, check with the clubhouse or look for an email.
Arrive 30 minutes prior to tee off time; leave clubs at Bag Drop. Check in with signup member. Tip the bag guys and pay for chip in and same day if applicable.

EQUIPMENT NEEDED

Balls, ball markers, tees, glove, towel, score counter or beads (if needed), Band-Aids, ball retriever, golf umbrella, water, insect repellent, sun screen.

Maximum number of clubs allowed is 14.

Bag tags are needed for correctly loading carts.

Tape your name address on clubs (mailing labels work well).

Be sure you can identify your ball.

ATTIRE:

Golf shirt, long shorts, slacks (no jeans), soft spike golf shoes or athletic shoes.

STARTING PLAY

Do not approach tee box until previous group has exited.

Place ball between appropriate markers. You may place behind markers up to two club lengths, but not in front of markers.

Hit your ball only after forward party is out of range. If the ball accidentally projects toward a player, yell "FORE" to warn her.

FAIRWAY ETIQUETTE

Keep up with group in front of you. **Driver and rider** advance cart to keep up with ball.

Observe fairway limitation signs and exit fairway by cart directional signs.

Never drive a cart on the green or over a tee box.

Be ready to hit your shot when it's your turn.

Fill divots, rake traps, repair ball dents on green.

If it's 'cart path only' take clubs you need onto the fairway to avoid returning to the cart.

When reaching your 'max', pick up – UNLESS the game requires counting putts; then you must finish the hole. Enter your 'max' and the number of putts.
