Assessment Payments- For those who pay their assessments monthly, please remember that payments are due on the 1st of each month. If you are set up on recurring E-checks through the portal, the payments are processed for free until December 30, 2025 (https://litchfieldbythesea.cincwebaxis.com/).

After that date, there will be a charge of \$1.99 for each payment. If you would like to sign up for the FREE ACH program, please complete and return the attached form once you have verified your bank routing and account number.

Golf Carts - We have received numerous reports regarding concerns about golf cart driving. Most of these issues involve underage drivers and unsafe operation of rented carts. We have contacted all the cart rental companies that work with LBTS to express our concerns and review their rental policies. Each company has stated that they explain our rules and ensure that only those legally permitted to operate the carts sign an acknowledgment of these rules. However, we know that these regulations are not always followed. If you observe a cart being driven by an underage operator or in an unsafe manner, please try to gather some of the following information: the name of the cart rental company, the address of the unit linked to the rental, and/or the identification number of the cart.

You may submit this information to Security or to the LBTS office by calling **843-223-5287** or emailing **Info@litchfieldbythesea.com**. We will then follow up with the cart owner to report the infraction and request any necessary measures needed to resolve the issue. We've also asked for additional explanation and review of the rules and consequences for violations at the time the rental agreement is executed. Thank you for your cooperation!

Larger Projects Riding the Tide- Every day we coordinate and perform minor repairs across both campuses (e.g., barcode readers malfunctioning, pool tiles damaged). However, larger projects are very visible, and we'd like to update you on those...

Architectural Fountains (roundabouts and beach club)- Beach Club installation is complete. Roundabout 1 (tennis courts) is ready to fill and then will require several visits for adjustments to optimize functioning. Roundabout 2 (in front of Bridgewater) is almost complete. Beach Club Deck- Repairs will wrap up today!

Osprey Lake Fountain- Two of the three fountains are operable. We have ordered a replacement saltwater pond/lake fountain, and it will be installed as soon as the architectural fountain work is complete. There is more work to be done and a consideration of lights or no lights (look for that survey soon!).

Beach Club Sunshades- The contractor repairing the beach club deck will repair and rehang the sail while working in the area. We are sourcing vendors to replace the sails and perform repairs/maintenance to these posts in September/October (weather always wins the scheduling battle).

Pickleball Court and River Club Pool Lights- The photocells have arrived and are being replaced. Fishing Pier/Boardwalk- Immediate repairs can be made to safely re-open this popular amenity while we work through the design process and planning needed for the extensive work. We expect repairs to begin on Monday (it was scheduled for last week but delayed by the rain) and hope to have this area available for interim use in the next two weeks.

Security Phone- We are updating the phone system at the main security office next month.

Landscape Maintenance Schedule (Week of August 4th – August 8th)

- Mowing: Mowing will continue daily on both properties (Weather Permitting). A large portion of rain is in the forecast for next week, so we will monitor that and pivot where necessary.
- Shrub, Palm, and Ornamental Grass Pruning: We will continue to prune Shrubs, Ornamental Grasses, and Tree Canopies. All Sable Palms on both properties will be pruned throughout the community to remove all dead fronds and seed pods. These trees will be hurricane cut. This was to be completed this past week, but due to the storms, the service was delayed.
- Spraying and Weeding: We will apply post-emergent herbicide to all garden beds to prevent new broadleaf weed growth. We will hand-pull existing weeds.
- Weed Eating and Edging: Trimming of grass along hard and soft edges, pond banks, flower beds, and fences will continue throughout the week.
- Blowing Off Hard Surfaces: All Common areas and hard surfaces will be blown off to remove debris and grass clippings.
- Irrigation: We will continue to monitor irrigation throughout both properties, especially with the high temperatures, to ensure proper water coverage for all flower beds and turf areas. We will also be repairing any leaks or broken spray nozzles and rotor heads.

Frozen Banana Peanut Butter Bites

These frozen banana bites are a healthy, energy-boosting dessert packed with natural sweetness and protein. With just a few ingredients and zero cooking, they're great to make ahead and store in a cooler until snack time.

Ingredients:

2 ripe bananas

½ cup peanut butter (or almond butter)

6 oz dark chocolate, melted

Sea salt or crushed nuts for topping (optional)

Instructions:

Slice bananas into ½-inch rounds.

Spread a small amount of peanut butter on a banana slice and top with another slice to make a "sandwich." Freeze for at least 1 hour until solid. Dip each frozen sandwich halfway in melted chocolate and place on a parchment-lined tray. Sprinkle with sea salt or chopped nuts, if desired, and freeze again until the chocolate is set. These frozen bites are creamy, crunchy, and sweet, with a touch of indulgence. They're the perfect beach dessert—cooling, satisfying, and easy to pop into your mouth between swims or sips of something tropical.

Waccamaw Bikeway

The Waccamaw Bikeway is an exceptionally popular paved trail that runs through the Pawleys Island, Litchfield and Murrells Inlet areas of Georgetown County. Most of the path runs parallel to Highway 17 from the South Causeway. It cuts down Waverly and Kings River roads to Willbrook Boulevard and back to Highway 17, where it crosses through beautiful Huntington Beach State Park, across the marsh in Murrells Inlet and up to the Georgetown/Horry County line. Originally known as the Bike the Neck project, the bikeway is part of the East Coast Greenway, a 3,000-mile trail system that runs along the eastern seaboard from Maine to Florida.
